

POOL OPENS SATURDAY, JUNE 6

Dear Heathlake Neighbors:

The Board would like to thank residents for their patience and cooperation during these difficult times.

Heathlake Community Association, Inc. Board of Directors does not recommend resident/guest use of community facilities during the CoVid19 pandemic.

Our community grounds, including tennis courts, pool, pool deck, pool furniture, restrooms, picnic tables, benches and playground equipment have not been sanitized – risk of infection exists.

However, the City of Houston Health Department has given us guidelines to open the pool. Residents may start using the pool at their own risk.

16 IS THE MAXIMUM TOTAL CAPACITY FOR THE POOL AND DECK (25% OF OUR NORMAL CAPACITY/SQUARE FOOT FORMULA PER CITY OF HOUSTON DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH), AS FOLLOWS:

BABY POOL – MAXIMUM **6** INDIVIDUALS

SHALLOW END – MAXIMUM **6** INDIVIDUALS

DEEP END – MAXIMUM **4** INDIVIDUALS

In Addition:

POOL AREA AND FURNITURE HAS NOT BEEN SANITIZED – RISK OF INFECTION EXISTS.

NO GUESTS DUE TO LIMITED CAPACITY. RESIDENTS ONLY.

RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BRINGING PERSONAL PROTECTIVE ITEMS THEY DEEM NECESSARY: MASKS, GLOVES, WIPES, DISINFECTANT, ETC.

RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING.

PLEASE LIMIT YOUR TIME AT THE POOL TO ONE HOUR IF OTHER RESIDENTS ARE WAITING

CITY OF HOUSTON CAN CLOSE OUR POOL AND FINE OUR COMMUNITY IF SOCIAL DISTANCING IS NOT MAINTAINED AND/OR MAXIMUM CAPACITY IS EXCEEDED.

NO POOL PARTIES WILL BE ALLOWED AT THIS TIME.
